QUITS AND RELEASES POLICY

REFUNDS: Quits and Releases

No Refunds after September 8th, 2011. Any applicable refund will be mailed, contingent to equipment returned and received in good condition.

Quits

Refund = 100% of registration – 10 % administration fee – 5% per week until equipment is returned and received in good condition. **Not applicable to quits after September 8th, 2011.**

Releases

Refund = 100% of registration – 10 % administration fee. Equipment must be returned within seven days.

VOLUNTEER EXPECTATIONS

Each family with a child playing or cheering is expected to volunteer for at least one home game. The team and squad managers will work with their volunteers to accommodate a schedule.

A football game can only start when:

1. Stick Crew (3) in place
2. Game Commissioner has filled out paperwork and is in place
3. 10-Play Counters (2) in place

The concession can only open when:

- Three concession workers (2-football and 1 – cheer) are in concession for the length of the entire game. Must be 16 years old or older.

COACHES, MANAGERS & TRAINERS

COACHING: Football Coaching Co-Coordinator, Vice President, Sandy Bains

Currently there are still a few positions open for coaches. If you are interested in coaching, please contact Sandy Bains by May 28th, 2011. NSMF coaches will be required to have obtained, at minimum, the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) Initiation to Community Sport (old Level 1), as well as, NCCP Ethics. Coaches are also required to sign and abide by Vancouver Mainland Football League's Coaches Code of Conduct and Football BC's Concussion Policy for Coaches.

ALL COACHES, MANAGERS AND TRAINERS ARE REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECK AS MANDATED BY FOOTBALL BC. SEE COACHING CO-ORDINATORS, SANDY BAINS FOR FOOTBALL OR TONI BUCKLEY FOR CHEERLEADING OR THE OFFICE FOR THE REQUIRED FORMS. CRIMINAL CHECKS ARE REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE OFFICE NO LATER THAN JULY 1, 2010

IN MEMORY



Rob Mountford November 18, 1943 - December 4, 2010

The "father" of North Surrey Football.

Rob joined the NSMF association in 1970 coaching the JB Lions. In years to come he would go on to coach the Bantam Bears and leading them to a Provincial Championship. He became President of NSMF in 1988 and held the position for 22 years until he retired in 2009. During his tenure, he also served on the board of directors of the VMFL starting in 1990.

Rob became a Vice President of the VMFL in 2000 until 2008. In 1999 he won the Football BC Builders Award and in 2009 he won the Orange Helmet Pioneer Award.

In honour of our beloved president, friend and mentor, all football helmets in the 2011 season will bear Rob's initials.
