

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES FORM

REMEMBER - Be calm and remain calm, when a child is injured...

1. Head Coach or Manager or Trainer calls 911 directly from where the child is.
Someone has a cell phone.
2. Do not leave the side of the injured child.
3. At Bear Creek Park YOU are responsible to call 911.
4. 911 operators will need the cell number you are calling from to call back to.
5. 911 operators will need the specific location in the park:
 - South/lower parking lot to access practice fields.
 - Access at southeastern corner by the playground and pool.
6. Immediately after 911, call Clubhouse or Announcing Tower on game days. Tell them:
 - Child has been injured
 - Ambulance has been called
 - Directions have been given to the ambulance
 - Injury *appears* to be _____
7. Continue to stay by the child until the ambulance arrives.
8. Give the paramedics copy of the Personal Medical History. This information helps the paramedics and the parents.

Flag and Cheerleading use north/upper parking lot by pavilion /NSMF Clubhouse. Executive will open entrance.

GAME DAY – emergency vehicles will always access from north or upper parking lot and gates will be opened for direct access to game field.
